



21st Century Skill: Communication

Activity Level: Grades K-4


“Show and Tell”

Step 1: Students should select something that is important to them, it could be a toy they have, their favorite book, an experience that they have had, etc.

Step 2: Students will then think about the following questions in regards to the object, experience, or book that they selected.

Show and Tell Question Prompts

Is it a/an...

 Object?	 Experience?	 Book?
Characteristics What is it made of? How does it make the sound? How does it move?	Feelings How does it make you feel? Why do you feel...?	Genre What kind of book is it? Why do you think the author wrote this book?
Purpose What is [this part] for? Why is there a...? When do you use/play with it?	Environment What did you see around you? Why do you like [the place]?	Story Which is your favourite part of the story? What happened at the end?
Meaning Why is it special to you?	People Who did you go with? What did you do with [name]?	Characters Who is your favourite character? Why?

Step 3: With the help of a parent/guardian/older sibling using a phone, computer, or i-pad, record a video no longer than 2 minutes long answering some of the questions above. It is okay to record the video a couple of times to get it how you want!

Some Tips for Show and Tell Video:

- Keep your head up and eyes focused on the camera as much as possible
- Use a loud and clear voice
- Keep your feet together and still while recording
- Try to use exciting words to describe your object, experience, or book.

Step 4: Save your video once you have it completed and done the way you would like.

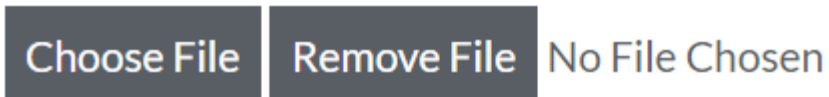

Step 6: Click on the submit 21st century skills activities button seen below.

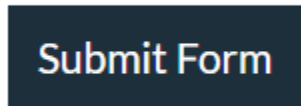


Step 7: Complete the submission form information and upload your video under the communication skills portion of the submission form seen below.
